Directions from I-75 and I-71

Take I-275 West from I-71 or I-75 to Exit 39
Exit right onto ramp towards Winton Rd / Fairfield / Forest Park
Keep left to stay on ramp towards Forest Park / Greenhills
Bear right (South) onto ramp towards S Gilmore Rd [Winton Rd]
Keep right (straight) onto Winton Rd
Turn left (East) onto Ingram Rd
Take immediate right onto Eswin (in front of Johnny's Toys)
Turn left (East) onto Enfield St (just before the shopping center/plaza)
Turn left onto Jack Malloy Lane (between the pool and the Greenhills Community Bldg)
Bear to the right of Jack Malloy Lane (this brings you to the rear of the building)
Take the first entrance, go up the stairs to the second floor, turn right to room 216 the last door on the left
